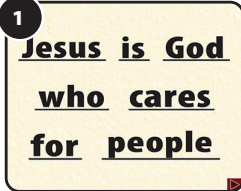

A. Slide 2

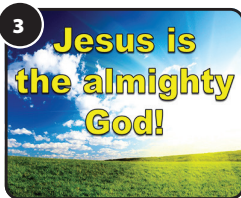
God began His great plan to redeem the world from sin.

3. Jesus was different from anyone else because He is God and man in one person.

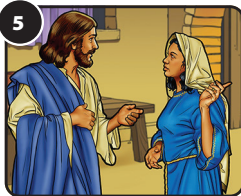

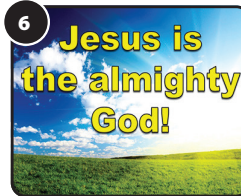
C. Slide 4 (John 2:1-3a)

E. Slide 6 (Word Up!)

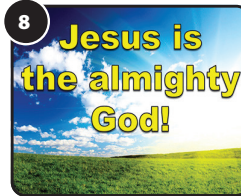


You can **believe Jesus is the almighty God. Praise Him!**

Jesus, who is God, created everything in the whole world just by speaking words. [Colossians 1:16]

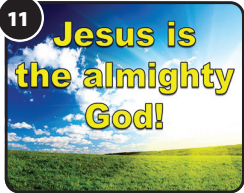
Jesus was starting to do things to show the people that He is the Redeemer.
