A. Slide 1
 God began His great plan to redeem the world from sin.
 1. Many of the Israelites were waiting for the Redeemer.
 Since Adam and Eve disobeyed God, we all want to go our own way. [Isaiah 53:6]

 1. Jesus and His disciples were invited to a wedding.
 2. The hosts ran out of wine.

 1. Mary told the servants to do whatever Jesus said.
 2. Mary knew Jesus could do a miracle because she believed Jesus is the almighty God.
- E. Slide 6** (Word Up!)

 1. Jesus told them to fill six huge jars with water.
 2. Jesus told the servants to give a cup of the water to the person in charge of the feast.
 3. Jesus turned the water into wine; He could do that because He is the almighty God.
- G. Slide 8** (Word Up!)
- H. Slide 9** (John 2:11a)
 Jesus, who is God, created everything in the whole world just by speaking words. [Colossians 1:16]
 Jesus was starting to do things to show the people that He is the Redeemer.
- I. Slide 10** (John 2:11b)
 Because of God's great love for you, Jesus bled and died on a cross to free you from your sin. [Revelation 1:5b]
- J. Slide 11** (Word Up!)

 Jesus truly is the Savior God the Father promised to send!
- III. CLIMAX**
 The disciples believed in Jesus that day! They began to put their trust in Him!
- IV. CONCLUSION**
 The disciples didn't completely understand who Jesus was, but the Bible says they believed.
 Jesus wants you to trust in Him completely as your Redeemer from sin. [John 20:31]
