1. Who told people the Redeemer would come? (*God; the prophets.*)
2. What does it mean for you that Jesus is the Redeemer? (*He is the Savior; the one who can save me from my sin.*)
3. What does the Bible call the twelve men who followed Jesus and learned from Him while He was on Earth? (*His disciples.*)
4. Who told Jesus about the problem at the wedding? (*His mother; Mary.*)
5. What did Jesus tell the servants to do with the large jars? (*Fill them with water.*)
6. What was Jesus showing about Himself when He used ordinary water to make wine? (*He is the almighty God who has power over everything.*)
7. What special book tells us many ways God shows His power? (*The Bible; God's Word.*)
8. After Jesus died on the cross, how did He prove He is almighty God? (*He came alive again.*)
9. What did the disciples think when they saw what Jesus did at the wedding? (*They were amazed; they believed in Him.*)
10. What does our memory verse say you must do to have everlasting life? (*Believe in Jesus.*)
11. If you have believed in Jesus as your Savior, what does it mean to you that Jesus is almighty? (*Answers will vary; He can help me with anything, etc.*)

Review Game

"Sentence Match-Up"

Materials:

"Sentence Match-Up" cards
(See GNC Resource Pack.)

Instructions:

Prepare 12 small paper rectangles of two different colors (six of each color) and label the back of each set with numbers 1 through 6. On the front of one set of cards, write the first half of one of the following statements. On the front of the other set, write the last half of one of the following statements.

Place cards in rows number side up in a pocket chart, tape them on a whiteboard or lay them on a table or on the floor in front of the class. When a child correctly answers a question, his team wins 1,000 points! Then let him choose a card of each set to try to make a match by forming a sentence. Announce the color and number on each card when it is chosen and then announce the words on each card as it is turned over so the children can try to remember what is on each card. If a sentence is formed, the team wins an additional 1,000 points! If the cards do not match, turn them back over and continue playing.

Preschool Review Game

"Water Bottles"

Materials:

Pitcher or bowl
Bottle of water
Cup

Instructions:

Provide a large pitcher or bowl and a smaller bottle of water. When a child correctly answers a question, help him carefully pour some of the water from the bottle into the pitcher or bowl. Remind the children of the servants in the story who obeyed Jesus' command to fill the jars with water. Be sure to ration the amount of water poured each time so that there is enough for each child to have a turn. (If needed, you can pour a small amount from the bottle into a paper cup and allow the child to pour that amount into the pitcher.)

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
