



WONDER TIME

“Praise Jesus, the Almighty God!”

Maybe you’ve already believed in Jesus as your Savior—that’s fantastic! When you believe in Jesus, you don’t just believe in Him for a moment—you believe in Him for your whole lifetime! Jesus wants you to know Him as He is—the almighty God. Say with me, **“Jesus is the almighty God!”** (*Say with children.*) You can **believe Jesus is the almighty God. Praise Him!** Praising Jesus means telling Him how amazing He is—how good and powerful and loving.

You can also thank God for the things He does, both big and small. He turns summer into fall. He brings rain for thirsty plants. Every day you can think about who Jesus is and what He has done for you. He knows everything that happens in your life. He solved your biggest problem by taking away your sin. Jesus is your Redeemer. He cares about all the things going on in your life! When you are sad or troubled, ask Him to help you. Continue to believe in Jesus—He is the almighty God. He is your Redeemer and He is doing things that show He cares for you. (*Read Jeremiah 32:17.*)

This week as you read your Bible, look for ways that God shows His power. Then praise God! Thank Jesus for being your Redeemer and remember His Holy Spirit is always with you. Let’s take a minute right now and praise Jesus for being the almighty God. (*Lead in prayer or ask several children or adult helpers to pray simple prayers of praise.*)

Jesus: God Who Cares for People

Because discipleship is fostered in small groups and individual settings, it is recommended that you break into your small groups for the *Wonder Time* teaching whenever possible, depending on the teaching and the dynamics of your club. This can help build trust with the children, address their questions, and encourage them to pursue their personal relationship with God.

You may choose to give children a *Wonder Devotional* or *Every Day with God* book, available from CEF Press. “Quiet Time Sheets” that correspond with each lesson are available in the GNC Resource Pack. Encourage children to use one or more in their Quiet Time each day. You may want to offer a reward to children who complete a certain number of lessons or bring back their completed “Quiet Time Sheets.”

Do your best to provide Bibles for children who don’t have one. There are also many free Bible reading apps available which you may point children to. For example Bible.is®, a free app produced by Faith Comes By Hearing®, allows children to both read and listen to the Bible.
