- A. Flashcard 2-1**
Nicodemus had some questions and he hoped he could find answers.
- B. Flashcard 2-2** (John 3:1)
1. Nicodemus was a Pharisee.
2. Pharisees tried to follow the laws to make themselves look good instead of following them because they loved God.
- C. Flashcard 2-3** (John 3:2)
Nicodemus knew there was something very different about Jesus because of the miracles He was doing.
- D. Flashcard 2-4** (John 3:2-3)
1. Nicodemus went to the place Jesus was staying to talk with Him.
Jesus came to the Earth He created to show how much He loves and cares for His Creation. [John 3:16]
2. Jesus told Nicodemus that he would have to be born again to see God's kingdom.
- E. Flashcard 2-5** (John 3:4-16)
1. Nicodemus did not understand.
If you have not trusted Jesus as Savior, your spirit is dead. [Ephesians 2:1-2a]
2. Nicodemus was born in sin but Jesus wanted him to know that to be born again is to be made new—alive instead of dead in sin.
3. Jesus reminded Nicodemus of the bronze snake.
4. Jesus would be lifted up on a cross.

Jesus came to the world to take your punishment for sin. [2 Corinthians 5:1a; 1 John 1:7b]
- III. CLIMAX**
Nicodemus needed to believe that only Jesus could save him from sin!
- IV. CONCLUSION**
If you've been born again, you are a new person in Christ. [2 Corinthians 5:17]
- No matter how many good things you do or how many rules you obey, your good works can never save you. [John 3:15]
