

Teaching the Song

Introduction: How many of you have a very best friend? What do you do together? (*Allow responses.*) There are lots of ways to spend time with a good friend. There is someone else who wants to spend time with you too. Let's sing and find out who it is.

Presentation: (*Sing the song for the children while showing the visual.*)

Explanation: Who wants to spend time with you? (*God.*) God is able to be everywhere and spend time with everyone at the same time—we say He is omnipresent. But we are not like Him in that way. We need quiet to pay attention to God. God wants you to spend some quiet time with Him every day. He will help you find the best time for you—morning and evening or some time in between. During your quiet time you can pray, read the Bible and even sing to Him. If you have received Jesus as your Savior, the Holy Spirit will show you the truth in God's Word. Write down these truths and ask God to help you remember and obey them.

Application: *Unsaved:* If you know you have sinned and believe Jesus died for you, you can receive Him today! God promises that if you receive Jesus as your Savior, your sins will be forgiven and you will have a friendship with God forever. If you have never received Jesus as Savior, you can do that right now.

Saved: If you have already received Jesus as your Savior, you already started your friendship with God. You can get to know Him more by having a daily quiet time with Him!

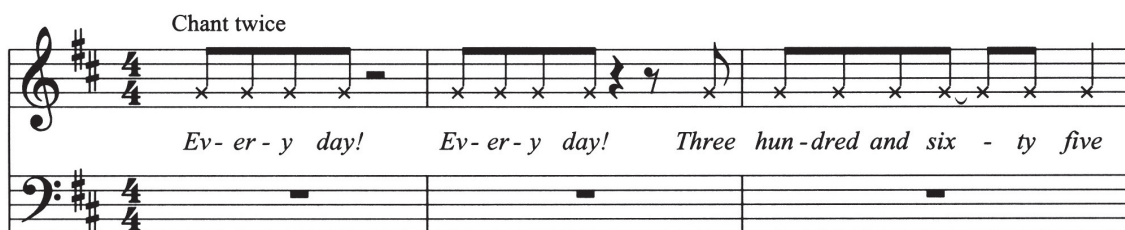

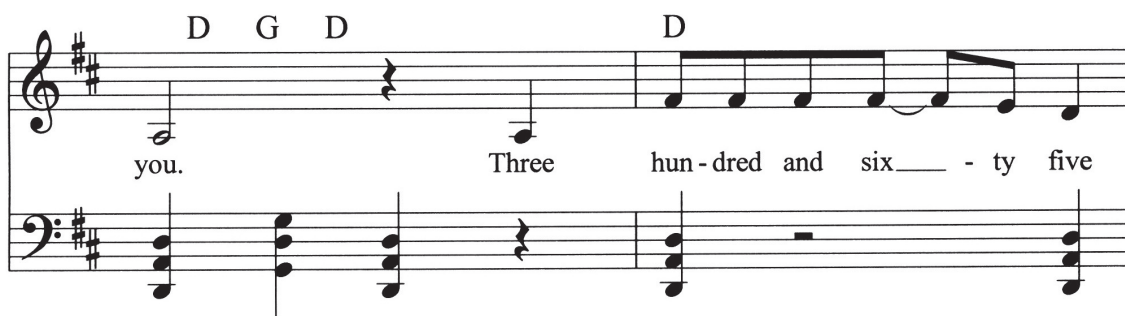

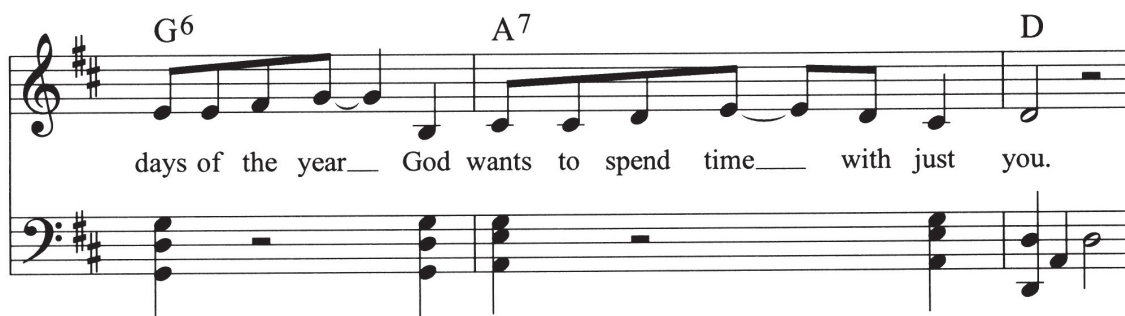
