The Jews and Samaritans hated each other.
- B. Flashcard 3-2** (John 4:1-6)
1. Jesus chose to walk right through Samaria.
2. If you have believed in Jesus, you are commanded to love everyone. [Matthew 5:44]
3. Jesus sat down to rest by a well.
- C. Flashcard 3-3** (John 4:7-9)
1. Jesus asked a Samaritan woman to give Him a drink of water.
2. The woman was surprised a Jewish man was speaking to her.
3. Jesus cares for every person because He created every person. [1 John 4:19]
- D. Flashcard 3-4** (John 4:10-26)
1. Jesus knew everything about her and loved her in spite of her sinfulness.
2. No one does right all the time except God. [Romans 3:10]
3. Jesus told the woman that He is the Messiah—the promised Savior.
4. God sent Jesus to save you, not to punish you for the wrong you have done. [John 3:17; Revelation 1:5b]
