1. Jesus asked a Samaritan woman to give Him a drink of water.
2. The woman was surprised a Jewish man was speaking to her.

 Jesus cares for every person because He created every person. [1 John 4:19]

Jesus cared about this woman.
 - I. **Slide 9** (John 4:10-26)
Jesus knew everything about her and loved her in spite of her sinfulness.
 - J. **Slide 10** ("Omniscient" Word Card)
 No one does right all the time except God. [Romans 3:10]
 - K. **Slide 11**
Jesus told the woman that He is the Messiah—the promised Savior.
 - L. **Slide 12** (Word Up!)
 God sent Jesus to save you, not to punish you for the wrong you have done. [John 3:17; Revelation 1:5b]

Jesus' words must have shocked the woman.
- III. CLIMAX**
Slide 14 (John 4:28-29)
She ran back to the city and told everyone to come and see Jesus, asking "Could He be the Christ (Messiah)?"
- IV. CONCLUSION**
Slide 15 (John 4:30, 39-42)
Many of the Samaritans believed on Jesus.
 Jesus knows all the bad things you have done and He still loves you. [Acts 16:31]
