



REVIEW QUESTIONS

1. Why wouldn't the Jews go to Samaria? (*They hated the Samaritans.*)
2. Why would Jesus choose to walk right through Samaria instead of going the long way? (*He loves all people.*)
3. Even though God loves you, how does God feel about your sin? (*He hates sin.*)
4. Our memory verse says God did not send Jesus into the world to do what? (*Condemn the world.*)
5. If Jesus is your Savior, what is something He wants you to do for everyone, even people you don't like? (*Love them; treat them right; answers may vary.*)
6. How can you love someone who is mean to you or who others don't like? (*Answers will vary; ask God for help to love that person.*)
7. What did Jesus ask the woman to give Him? (*A drink of water.*)
8. Was Jesus surprised when the woman said she didn't have a husband? Why or why not? (*No; He knew all about her life because He is God and knows everything.*)
9. Who did Jesus tell the woman He is? (*The Messiah; the promised Savior.*)
10. What do you need to believe about Jesus to be saved? (*He is the only one who can save me from my sins; He died and rose again for me.*)
11. After talking with Jesus, what did the woman say to the people in the city? (*Come see a man who told me everything I've done. Could He be the Messiah?*)
12. Why did the people hurry to see Jesus? (*They were surprised at the woman's words; they wanted to see if Jesus truly was the promised Savior.*)



PRESCHOOL REVIEW QUESTIONS

1. Who did Jesus meet when He went to Samaria? (*A woman.*)
2. What did Jesus ask the woman to give Him? (*A drink of water.*)
3. How many things did Jesus know about the woman? How many things does Jesus know about you? (*Everything!*)
4. Who is Jesus? (*The promised Savior.*)

Review Game "Give or Keep"

Materials:
"Give or Keep" cards
(See GNC Resource Pack.)

Instructions:
Prepare eight blue squares and eight red squares. Mark point values on the back of each square and place them in a bag or box. Divide children into a red team and a blue team and ask questions, alternating between teams. When a child answers correctly, give his team 100 points and let him draw a card from the bag. If a red square is drawn, the points on the card go to the red team. If the square is blue, the points go to the blue team.

Preschool Review Game "Red or Blue"

Prepare eight blue squares and eight red squares and put them in a bag. When a child correctly answers a question, let him reach into the bag and pull out a square. If the square is red, have everyone clap their hands. If the square is blue, have everyone stomp their feet. If possible, repeat until all children have a chance to answer a question and pull out a square.
