II. PROGRESSION OF EVENTS

A. Flashcard 4-1 (John 4:46-47a)

1. A nobleman's son was very sick.
With sin came sickness, death and all kinds of sadness. [Romans 5:12]
2. The nobleman had heard about a man named Jesus and the amazing things He was doing.
3. The nobleman left his home and began walking about 15 miles to find Jesus.



B. Flashcard 4-2 (John 4:47b-49)

- The nobleman asked Jesus to come and heal his son.
Jesus could do these amazing miracles because He is God. [Jeremiah 31:3b]



C. Flashcard 4-3 (John 4:50a)

1. Jesus told the nobleman to go back home—his son would live!
2. Jesus is omnipotent—all powerful.
Jesus came to the Earth He created to bring life where there was sickness and death. [Revelation 1:5b]



D. Flashcard 4-4 (John 4:50b)

- The nobleman believed that Jesus could heal his son just by speaking the word.



E. Flashcard 4-5 (John 4:51-53a)

- The servants ran to tell the nobleman his son was getting better.
If you have believed on Jesus, God's promises to you are in His true Word, the Bible. [Hebrews 13:5b-6a; 1 John 1:9]

III. CLIMAX

At the exact moment that Jesus said, "Your son will live!" the boy started getting better.
