C. Slide 4 (John 4:47b-49)

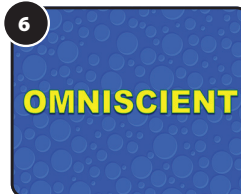
The nobleman asked Jesus to come and heal his son.

Jesus could do these amazing miracles because He is God. [Jeremiah 31:3b]

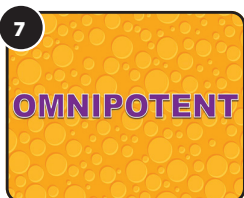


D. Slide 5 (John 4:50a)

- I. **Slide 11** (Word Up!)
 If you have believed on Jesus, God's promises to you are in His true Word, the Bible. [Hebrews 13:5b-6a; 1 John 1:9]



- J. **Slide 12**
When Jesus said the boy would get well, he did!
