II. PROGRESSION OF EVENTS

- A. **Slide 2** (John 4:46-47a)
A nobleman's son was very sick.
 With sin came sickness, death and all kinds of sadness. [Romans 5:12]
- B. **Slide 3** (Bible Map)
1. The nobleman had heard about a man named Jesus and the amazing things He was doing.
2. The nobleman left his home and began walking about 15 miles to find Jesus.
- C. **Slide 4** (John 4:47b-49)
The nobleman asked Jesus to come and heal his son.
 Jesus could do these amazing miracles because He is God. [Jeremiah 31:3b]
- D. **Slide 5** (John 4:50a)
Jesus told the nobleman to go back home—his son would live!
- E. **Slide 6** ("Omniscient" Word Card)
- F. **Slide 7** ("Omnipotent" Word Card)
Jesus is omnipotent—all powerful.
- G. **Slide 8**
 Jesus came to the Earth He created to bring life where there was sickness and death. [Revelation 1:5b]
- H. **Slide 9** (John 4:50b)
The nobleman believed that Jesus could heal his son just by speaking the word.
- I. **Slide 10** (John 4:51-53a)
The servants ran to tell the nobleman his son was getting better.
- J. **Slide 11** (Word Up!)
- K.  If you have believed on Jesus, God's promises to you are in His true Word, the Bible. [Hebrews 13:5b-6a; 1 John 1:9]
- Slide 12**
When Jesus said the boy would get well, he did!

III. CLIMAX

At the exact moment that Jesus said, "Your son will live!" the boy started getting better.

- Slide 13** (John 4:53b-54)
The Bible tells us that the man and everyone in his house believed on Jesus!
 Will you believe on Jesus?
[John 3:36a]
