



REVIEW QUESTIONS

1. Why did Jesus come to Earth? *(To bring life—everlasting life for those who would believe on Him.)*
2. What is the only way you can be forgiven and be close to God? *(Believe on Jesus as your Savior.)*
3. Why was the nobleman sad? *(His son was very sick.)*
4. What did the nobleman have to do to get to Jesus? *(Walk 15 miles to where Jesus was.)*
5. What did the nobleman ask Jesus to do? *(Come and heal his son.)*
6. Why could Jesus do the amazing miracles the people were all talking about? *(He is God; He has power over everything.)*
7. What did Jesus tell the nobleman? *(Go back home. Your son will live.)*
8. What does the word omnipotent mean? *(All powerful [show card if child has difficulty remembering].)*
9. What did the nobleman's servants say when they ran out to meet him? *(Your son lives!)*
10. According to our memory verse, when do you receive eternal life? *(When I believe on the Son—Jesus.)*
11. If you have believed on Jesus as your Savior, what else can you believe about God? *(God's promises in His Word are true; I can trust God; answers may vary.)*
12. How can you know God's promises are true? *(Because God always speaks the truth; answers may vary.)*



PRESCHOOL REVIEW QUESTIONS

1. Why was the nobleman sad? *(Because his son was very sick.)*
2. What did the nobleman ask Jesus to do? *(He asked Jesus to heal his son.)*
3. Why could Jesus heal the nobleman's son? *(Because He is God; because He is all powerful; answers may vary.)*
4. Where can you find God's true promises? *(In His Word; the Bible.)*

Materials:

Box or bag

Instructions:

Write out sentences about times that God cares for children; e.g. you are sad, you are afraid, you are in the dark, you are alone, you lose a game, you hurt your knee, you are angry, you feel sick, you fall down, you are sleeping, you are feeling happy, etc. Cut the sentences apart and put each one into a box or bag. When a child correctly answers a question, give his team 1,000 points then have all the children shout "God cares when..." as the child chooses a sentence and uses motions and facial expressions to act it out for his team. If his team guesses correctly what it is, give them an extra 1,000 points.
