Lesson Outline

I. INTRODUCTION

Imagine what it would be like to live without ever being able to see!

II. PROGRESSION OF EVENTS

The Bible tells us about a man who lived in Jericho. He was blind!

A. **Slide 1** (Mark 10:46; Luke 18:35)

Bartimaeus sat by the roadside and begged for money.

 Living in sin is like being in darkness because you are apart from God and can't find Him on your own. [John 3:19]

B. **Slide 2**

1. Bartimaeus must have heard about Jesus.

2. All the people of Israel were waiting for the Savior God had promised to send.

C. **Slide 3** (Bible Map)

D. **Slide 4** (Mark 10:46; Luke 18:35-37)

1. It was time for the special feast and many people traveled through Jericho to get to Jerusalem.

2. Someone told Bartimaeus that Jesus was coming.

E. **Slide 5** (Mark 10:47-49a; Luke 18:38-40a)

Bartimaeus called out to Jesus for mercy.

F. **Slide 6** (Word Up!)

Jesus immediately stopped walking.

 God loves you and wants to show mercy to you.

[Ephesians 2:4]

G. **Slide 7**

Jesus loved Bartimaeus and wanted to show him mercy.

H. **Slide 8** (Mark 10:49b-52a; Luke 18:40b-42)

1. Jesus told Bartimaeus to come to Him.

 Jesus is perfect and didn't deserve to die, but He willingly bled and died so that you could be forgiven. [Colossians 1:13-14]

2. Bartimaeus told Jesus that he wanted to see.

3. He believed Jesus was the promised Savior and could take away his blindness.

III. CLIMAX

Slide 9 (Mark 10:52b; Luke 18:43)

Bartimaeus could see!

IV. CONCLUSION

A. Bartimaeus and all the people who had seen him receive his sight praised God.

B. **Slide 10** (Word Up!)

 God wants you to praise Him for all the good things He does—even if He does them for someone else. [Philippians 4:4a]

C. **Slide 11**

The Bible tells us Bartimaeus followed Jesus.

 God loves you and wants to show mercy to you.

[Acts 16:31]
