

**REVIEW QUESTIONS**

1. What does the word "Psalms" mean? (*Songs.*)
2. Why were the people of Israel not happy with Samuel's sons being judges? (*Samuel's sons were more interested in money and getting their own way.*)
3. What did the people want Samuel to give them? (*A king like all the other nations had.*)
4. What are some ways boys and girls follow others instead of following God? (*Answers will vary.*)
5. Who did God have Samuel anoint as the first king of Israel? (*Saul.*)
6. What did the people of Israel do when they heard the Philistines were coming to attack? (*They ran away from Saul and hid.*)
7. What direction was Saul supposed to follow? (*Wait seven days for Samuel to come and offer the sacrifice.*)
8. What did Saul do instead? (*Saul offered the sacrifice.*)
9. What can you do when you are tempted to follow others instead of following God? (*Remember who God is; ask advice from someone who follows God; read the Bible; answers will vary.*)
10. What is God like? (*Answers will vary but could include He is in charge, loving, kind, patient, good, etc.*)
11. When Samuel arrived, what hard message did he have for Saul because Saul had disobeyed? (*The kingdom is taken from you; God has chosen a man after His own heart to be the next king.*)
12. Say our memory verse. (*Quote Psalm 119:9.*)

**PRESCHOOL REVIEW QUESTIONS**

1. What did the people of Israel want? (*A king.*)
2. What is it called when you go your own way instead of God's way? (*Sin.*)
3. What was the name of the first king of Israel? (*Saul.*)
4. What is God like? (*Loving, kind, patient, etc.*)

Review Game
"Who's The King?"

Materials:
"Crown" visual
(See GNC Resource Pack.)

Instructions:
This game can be played in teams or as one group. When a child correctly answers a question, have him turn his back to the group and close his eyes while you give a paper crown to one of the other children. That child then hides it behind his back. The child with his eyes closed turns back around and tries to guess who has the crown. Let him guess several times before revealing who has the crown. If he guesses correctly, his team gets 100 points.

Variation:
If you have a very large group, give the child who is guessing hints about who has the crown such as "It's someone in the second row," "It's a boy who is wearing green," or "It's one of the teachers."

Preschool Review Game
"Who's the King? Junior"

Materials:
Paper crown

Instructions:
Have one teacher close his eyes while you ask the questions. When a child correctly answers a question, give him a paper crown to hide behind his back. Tell all the children to put their hands behind their backs and have the other teacher open his eyes and try to guess who has the crown.
