A. Flashcard 2-1 (1 Samuel 16:1-3)

2. God wanted Samuel to go to Bethlehem to anoint a new king.
3. Samuel was afraid Saul would kill him if he went.



- ### B. Flashcard 2-2 (1 Samuel 16:4)
- Samuel went to Bethlehem, and the leaders were concerned.



C. Flashcard 2-3 (1 Samuel 16:5-11)

1. Samuel invited Jesse and his sons to come to the sacrifice.
 Your value is not in what you look like or what you have. God wants His children to have hearts that love and obey Him. [Jeremiah 17:10a]
2. Samuel waited carefully for God's direction.
3. None of Jesse's older sons were the one God wanted to be king.
4. Samuel asked if these were all of Jesse's sons.
5. Samuel sent for David.



- ### D. Flashcard 2-4 (1 Samuel 16:11)
1. David was a shepherd.
 2. David hurried to his father's house.



E. Flashcard 2-5 (1 Samuel 16:12)

1. God could see David's heart because God is omniscient.
2. God told Samuel to anoint David.
3. David was a man after God's heart.
 When you love God, the Holy Spirit will work in you to help you obey Him. [Psalm 139:23-24]



- ### F. Flashcard 2-6 (1 Samuel 16:12)
- Samuel anointed David.
