Lesson Outline

- I. INTRODUCTION**
Today we're going to measure a few things and see how tall they are.
- II. PROGRESSION OF EVENTS**
 - A. **Slide 1** (1 Samuel 16:13-23; 17:1-3)
 1. God chose David because David was a man after God's heart.
 2. David played the harp at the palace when Saul felt sad.
 - B. **Slide 2** (Bible Map)
 1. The Philistines wanted to start a war with Israel.
 2. Armies gathered on opposite mountains, and each would send one soldier to fight for them.
 - C. **Slide 3** (1 Samuel 17:4-11)
 1. The Philistine champion was a giant named Goliath.
 2. Goliath came into the valley and shouted at the Israelites twice a day.
 3. King Saul and the Israelite army were terrified by the threats of Goliath.
 - D. **Slide 4** (Word Up!)

To be bold is to stand up for what you know God says is right and true but to do it in a right way. When you are bold for God, He gets glory! [1 John 4:4b]

 - F. **Slide 6** (1 Samuel 17:12-22)
 1. David's father sent him to take food and check on his brothers in the army camp.
 2. David delivered the food and joined his brothers.
 - G. **Slide 7** (1 Samuel 17:23-31)
 1. Goliath challenged the Israelites.
 2. David asked about Goliath.
 3. David was angry as he heard his country and his God being threatened.
 4. Eliab got angry at David.
 5. King Saul heard of David and sent for him.
 - H. **Slide 8** (1 Samuel 17:32-39)
 1. David said he would fight Goliath.
 2. David said God would deliver him from the Philistine.
 - I. **Slide 9** (Word Up!)

You can be bold for God because of God's power.
 - J. **Slide 10**

David was bold because he trusted in God.
 - K. **Slide 11** (1 Samuel 17:40-49)
 1. David and Goliath met each other to fight.
 2. David wanted all the Earth to know the God of Israel.
 - L. **Slide 12** (Word Up!)

God's plan is that the whole world would know that He is the one true God.
 - M. **Slide 13**
 1. David took a stone and placed it in his sling.
 2. It sank deep into Goliath's forehead.
- III. CLIMAX** (1 Samuel 17:50)
God won the victory through David as the mighty Goliath crashed to the ground.

 - A. The Philistines ran for their lives.
