Psalm 119:11

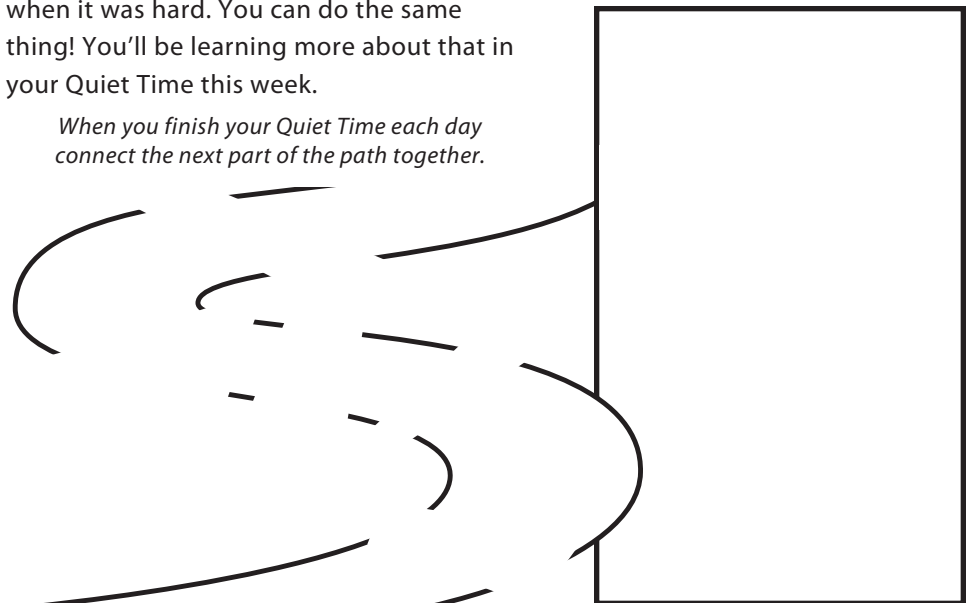
Unscramble the hearts as you say the memory verse.

① READ ABOUT IT!

"I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you."

—Psalms 119:11

③ PRAY ABOUT IT!

Thank God for giving you the Bible so you can know more about Him.

② THINK ABOUT IT!

Psalms are songs. The Psalms in the Bible are songs the Israelites would sing to or about God. Psalm 119 was probably written by King David. It is all about how wonderful God's Word is! Knowing God's Word can help you trust His plans.

Day 2
① READ ABOUT IT!

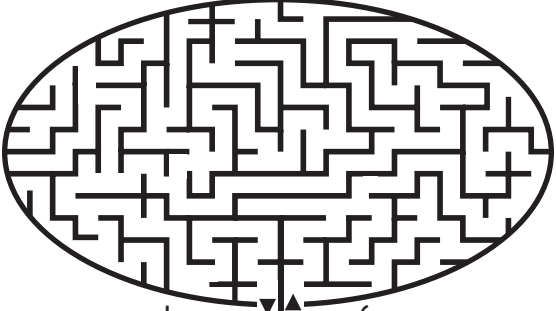
"For my thoughts are not your ways, declares the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts."

② THINK ABOUT IT!

God's thoughts and ways are not the same as ours. You may not always understand why God doesn't do things the way you think He should. But God is perfect! He knows exactly what He is going to do. He will make all things right in His way and His time.

① READ ABOUT IT!

—Romans 8:28

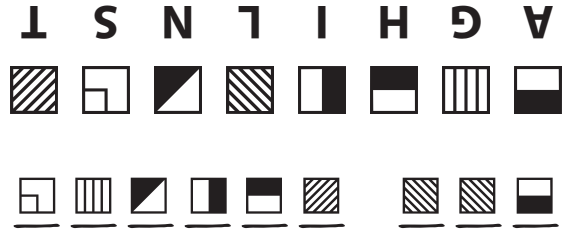
③ PRAY ABOUT IT!

Thank God that He works all things out for good.

② THINK ABOUT IT!

Life isn't perfect and hard things sometimes happen, but God is stronger than anything that could ever happen. He didn't just work in the past. He doesn't just work in the future. He's also here in the present—right now. He promises to those who have believed in Jesus that all things, even the bad things, He will work for good. That's why you can trust His plan.

Day 4
① READ ABOUT IT!

"Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean [trust] on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths."

—Proverbs 3:5-6

③ PRAY ABOUT IT!

Talk to God about the things going on in your life. Ask Him to help you trust Him more and thank Him for directing the path of your life.

② THINK ABOUT IT!

It can be hard to trust God's plan. But when you trust Him completely—more than your own ideas or what you think your heart wants—He will lead you the right way. To acknowledge Him in all your ways means to give Him every part of your life. Trust Him every day with the big things and the small things too.
