

Teaching for “Jesus Is Caring for You”

Introduction: It’s great to have people who love and take care of you, isn’t it? Who are some people who care for you? *(Allow response. Answers may include parents, teachers, friends, etc.)* Can any of these people be with you all the time? *(Allow response.)* No. But I know someone who can be with you and take care of you all the time. This song tells about Him.

Presentation: *(Sing the song with the visual.)*

Explanation: *Verse 1:* You don’t have to be afraid even if you’re all alone or it’s dark outside, if your parents are fighting, or if you’re being made fun of at school. If you have Jesus as your Savior, He is right there with you. You can talk to Him in prayer about your fears and He will hear you and help you be brave. Being brave doesn’t mean that things don’t scare you. It means that you can calmly face those scary things because you know God is with you.

Chorus: Jesus is always there helping you and taking care of you no matter where you are. He loves you and cares about everything that happens to you.

Verse 2: You can’t see Jesus, but He is there! You’re never alone because He is always with you. Jesus knows when you sit and stand up, He sees you when you’re afraid, He even knows what you’re going to do tomorrow. Nothing can happen to you that He doesn’t know about!

Application: *Saved*—If you have believed in Jesus as your Savior, you don’t have to be afraid. Trust Him to take care of you in the way He knows is best for you. When you are afraid, pray! Talk to God about what you’re afraid of and ask Him to help you remember He is with you and cares about you.

Unsaved—Jesus has a special kind of care for those who are part of God’s family. He is always with those who have believed in Him, loving them and caring for them. You can become a part of God’s family and know that Jesus is always caring for you! The Bible says that Jesus loves you so much that He took the punishment you deserve for your sin (wrong things you do) by dying on the cross and coming back to life. Will you believe in Jesus today and become part of God’s family? When you believe, you can be sure Jesus will be with you to care for you always.

Repetition: *(Have all the children sing the song with you. Then let the girls sing the verses and the boys the chorus. Switch parts and sing again.)*
