

The resources available in this pack are to assist you, the teacher. They are not requirements. Use them as they work best with your particular club dynamics.

Lesson Reproducibles

• Lesson 2

- ☐ “Right Hearts” reproducible (*Review Game*)
 - Make one photocopy of the “Right Hearts” reproducible and cut out the hearts. Put these hearts in the bag for the review game (p. 25).
- ☐ “What’s in Your Heart?” reproducible (*Review Game*)
 - Make one photocopy of the “What’s in Your Heart?” reproducible. Cut out the hearts and adhere one to each container needed for the review game (p. 25).
- ☐ “Wrong Hearts” reproducible (*Review Game*)
 - Make one photocopy of the “Wrong Hearts” reproducible and cut out the hearts. Put these hearts in the bag for the review game (p. 25).

• Lesson 3

- ☐ “Paper Heart” reproducible (*Small Group Time*)
 - Photocopy enough so that every child has a heart. Have the children write in the heart as you discuss the Small Group Time teaching (p. 27). (Also used in Lesson 6.)
- ☐ “Wandering” skit reproducible (*Memory Verse*)
 - Make two photocopies of the “Wandering” skit reproducible for the volunteers to read during the introduction of the Memory Verse (p. 28).
- ☐ “David and Saul” skit reproducible (*Bible Lesson*)
 - Make two photocopies of the “David and Saul” skit reproducible for the volunteers to read during the Bible Lesson (p. 31).

• Lesson 4

- ☐ “Square Pattern” reproducible (*Small Group Time*)
 - Make one photocopy for each of the Small Group leaders. Use this pattern during Small Group Time (p. 37).

• Lesson 5

- ☐ “Crown” reproducible (*Small Group Time*)
 - Photocopy enough so that every child has a crown. During Small Group Time have the children write the letters of the word “kind” when the leader instructs them to (p. 47).
- ☐ “GNC TV” skit reproducible (*Bible Lesson*)
 - Make two photocopies of the “GNC TV” skit reproducible for the volunteers to read as an optional alternative to the Bible Lesson introduction (p. 48).
- ☐ “Every Other Word” reproducible (*Memory Verse*)
 - Make one photocopy and cut apart the phrases. Use in the verse repetition (p. 52).
- ☐ “David’s Table” reproducible (*Review Game*)
 - Photocopy one for each team in the Review Game. Cut out pieces and use as instructed (p. 53).

• Lesson 6

- ☐ “God’s Heart Word Search” reproducible (*Interactive Game*)
 - Make one photocopy of the “God’s Heart Word Search” reproducible for each child in your club. If you would rather have the children work in teams to complete the word search, photocopy one for each team you will have. Have the children complete this word search as a fun game during your party.
- ☐ “Movie Scene Clapperboard” reproducible (*Schedule*)
 - Make several copies of the “Movie Scene Clapperboard” reproducible. Write the different segments of your party club on the back and write the number on the front in the order that you’ll be doing them in club. Place around the room and have children grab the next number to find out what is next in club (p. 55).
- ☐ “What’s in God’s Heart?” reproducible (*Interactive Game*)
 - Make one photocopy of the “What’s in God’s Heart?” reproducible and post “God’s Heart” on one side of the room and “Not God’s Heart” on the other (p. 61).

- ☐ “Paper Heart” reproducible (*Interactive Game*)
 - Make one photocopy for each team during the “Have a Heart Remote Control Relay” game (p. 61).
- ☐ “Act It Out” reproducible (*Interactive Game*)
 - Make one photocopy of the “Act It Out” reproducible. Cut out the cards and put them in a container for the “Act It Out Just for Fun” game (p. 61).

Verse Reproducibles

• Lesson 1

- ☐ “Psalm 119” verse reproducible (*Wonder Time™*)
 - Make one photocopy for every child in your club. Encourage them to read eight verses of Psalm 119 every day (p. 13).

• Lesson 3

- ☐ “God, Your Champion” verse reproducible (*Wonder Time*)
 - Make one photocopy of the “God, Your Champion” verse reproducible and cut apart the strips. Hand the strips to older children to read during Wonder Time (p. 34).

Resource Booklet

• Lessons 1—5

- ☐ “Heart” visual (*Wonder Time*)
 - Cut out the large heart. Adhere it to a white board or poster board or tape to a wall in a way where it can be reused. Use as instructed (pp. 13, 24, 34, 44, 52).

• Lesson 1

- ☐ “Clean Up Motions” cards (*Memory Verse*)
 - Cut out each card and place in a container and use as instructed during the verse repetition (p. 13).
- ☐ “Crown” visual (*Wonder Time*)
 - Cut out the crown and adhere it to the inside of the “Heart” visual (p. 13).
- ☐ “Crown” visual (*Review Game*)
 - Use the “Crown” visual from Wonder Time as instructed during the “Who’s the King?” review game (p. 17).

• Lesson 2

- ☐ “Whole Heart/Half Heart” card (*Memory Verse*)
 - Cut out the heart. Instead of using two hearts as the verse repetition says, use this one and fold/unfold for a whole heart or half heart (p. 21).
- ☐ “Omniscient” word card (*Bible Lesson, Wonder Time*)
 - Cut out the card and use when called for during the lesson and Wonder Time (pp. 22-24).

- ☐ “God’s Heart” word cards (*Wonder Time*)
 - Cut out cards and use as directed (p. 24).

• Lesson 3

- ☐ “God, Your Champion” word card (*Wonder Time*)
 - Cut out card and use as instructed in Wonder Time (p. 34).

• Lesson 4

- ☐ “Treasure Hunt” cards (*Memory Verse*)
 - Cut out and place throughout your club location. Use as directed during the verse repetition (p. 38).
- ☐ “God’s Plan” heart cards (*Gospel Spotlight*)
 - Cut out cards and hand to child to read as instructed in the Gospel Spotlight (p. 39).

- ☐ “Heart” visual (*Wonder Time*)
 - Use the “Heart” visual again as instructed (p. 44).

- ☐ “ZERO—Heart Edition” cards (*Review Game*)
 - Cut out each card. Place in a container to draw out as children answer the questions correctly (p. 45).

• Lesson 6

- ☐ “Remote Control” visual
 - Cut out the remote control and mount it on foam core. Cut out the second set of buttons and adhere them over the remote control buttons with foam tape. This will help the children feel like they are pushing the buttons. Use throughout the party as directed.
- ☐ “ZERO—Heart Edition” cards (*Review Game*)
 - Use the cards from Lesson 5, but remove the ZERO cards. Use as instructed (p. 57).

Timeline and Bible Map

Utilize the Timeline and Bible Map to help your students better understand where and when events happened in history.

Note: The Timeline and Bible Map are provided in the Starter Resource Pack. You can place the Timeline on a wall or put each piece on thick cardboard and tape them together so it folds accordion-style. This allows the visual to be folded for easy moving and storage and unfolded to stand on its own.

Visualized Bible Verse Booklet

Use the Visualized Bible Verse Booklet during the Memory Verse teaching in each *Good News Club*®. If you quote the memory verse during the Bible lesson or other club segments, you may show the Visualized Bible Verse Booklet to help the children remember the verse.

Word Up! Booklet

Hold up the Word Up! card each time you want the children to repeat that day's Word Up! Be sure to explain the Word Up! at the beginning of the club hour. Word Up! explanations are provided in the Bible lesson text after each Small Group Time.

Quiet Time Sheets

Photocopy one double-sided "Quiet Time Sheet" for each child and hand out at the end of each club. Encourage the children to have a Quiet Time each day and bring back their "Quiet Time Sheet" the next week. During Small Group Time, discuss with the children what they learned during their Quiet Times that week. If desired, offer a reward to those who bring back their completed "Quiet Time Sheet."
