③ PRAY ABOUT IT!

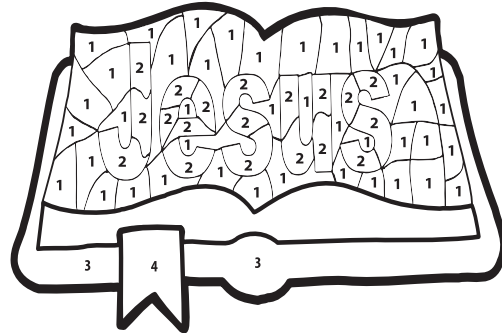
Ask God to help you see and understand more things about Him as you read the Bible and as you learn your memory verses.

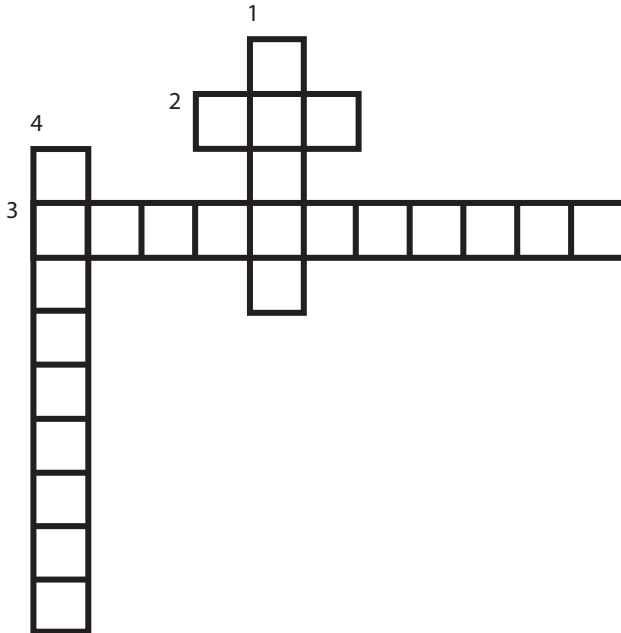
As you have your Quiet Time each day, be sure to read and think about this week's memory verse. It has a wonderful promise in it!

John 3:16

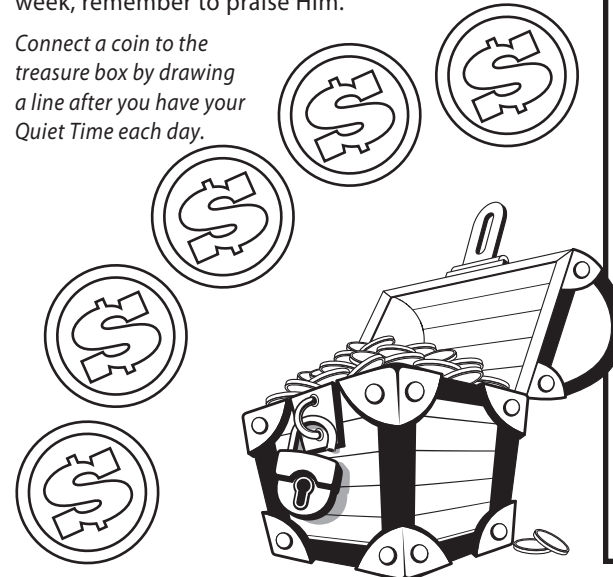

"And he [Jesus] is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world." —1 John 2:2

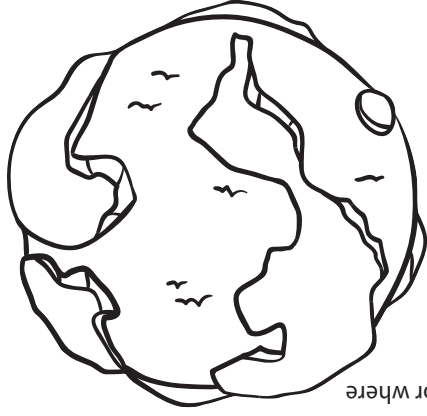
3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Thank God that Jesus has the power to save everyone everywhere who puts his or her trust in Him!

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

Propitiation—now that is a big word! Here is how to say it: pro-pit-she-a-shun. It means that Jesus did what God required so you could be saved. If you have believed in Jesus, He took your punishment for sin. He didn't run out of power to save after He took your sins. He has the power to save everyone in the world who believes in Him no matter who they are or where they live.

1 READ ABOUT IT!

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!
