

1 READ ABOUT IT!

"The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love."

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Ask God to help you notice ways that you can show His kindness to others. Thank Him for the mercy He has shown to you.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

John 3:17

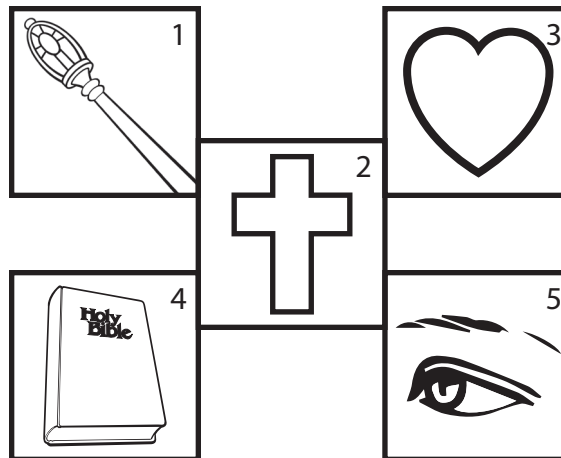
"Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him."
