

① READ ABOUT IT!

"Through faith we understand that the worlds [universe] were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear." —**Hebrews 11:3**

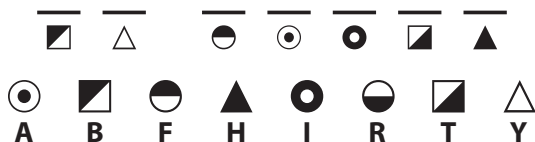
③ PRAY ABOUT IT!

Just like we can have faith that God created the world and that Jesus died for our sins, we can have faith that God is with us and helping us every day, even when we can't see it. Ask God to help you have faith in Him and trust Him today.

② THINK ABOUT IT!

When God created the world, He spoke words to make what He wanted. Only God can create things by speaking them into existence! You didn't see God do this but you can have faith and know it's true. Faith is being sure of something even when we can't see it. It is by faith that you can know God created the world. It's also by faith that you can know Jesus died for your sins and came alive again. It is only through Jesus that you can have the special friendship with God that you were created to have. Do you have faith in Jesus as your Savior?

WORD UP! God knows everything!

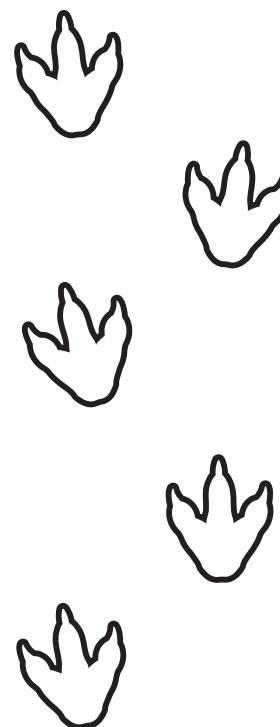
Say the memory verse out loud each day this week. When you feel like you know it really well, go tell it to someone who may have never heard it before.

Day 1 **GOD KNOWS EVERYTHING!**

① READ ABOUT IT!

"For there is not a word in my tongue, but, lo, O Lord, thou knowest it altogether."

—Psalm 139:4

② THINK ABOUT IT!

God really does know everything, even the things you never say out loud. God knows everything about *you*! The chapter in the Bible where this verse is found talks about how God knows everything about your life, and how God created you with love and care. If you have a Bible, you can read the whole chapter.

③ PRAY ABOUT IT!

Thank God for knowing and caring about the things you wrote down. Thank Him for how He created you. Thank Him for caring about and knowing you perfectly.

Day 2 **GOD IS ALL-POWERFUL!**

① READ ABOUT IT!

"Great is our Lord, and of great power: his understanding is infinite." —Psalm 147:5

② THINK ABOUT IT!

God is so great! He is of great power—that means He is all powerful! This is why He was able to create everything in the entire universe just by speaking. When the verse says that God's "understanding is infinite" it means that God's knowledge has no limit. God knows things that we never could, and we can trust Him.

① READ ABOUT IT!

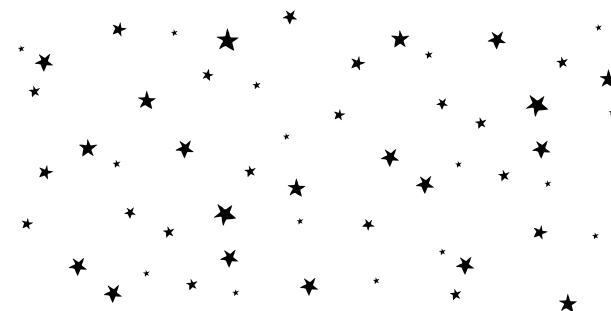
