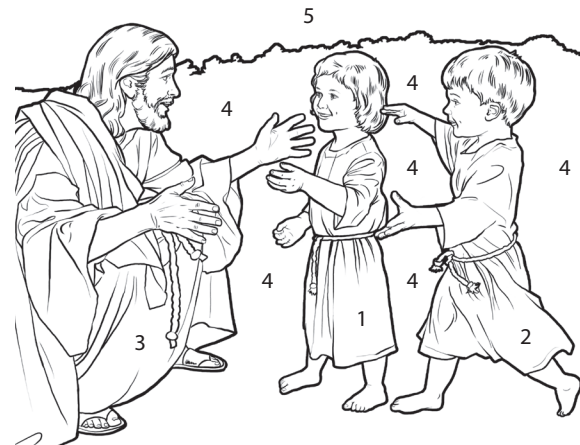

1 READ ABOUT IT!

"In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son..."

—1 John 4:10

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

What is love? That's a very important question! God showed us what true love is when He sent Jesus as the perfect sacrifice for our sin. This means he died to take the punishment you deserve for your sin. Jesus was the only one who could do this because He is God's Son. If you have trusted in Jesus as your Savior, you will live with God forever! Even death doesn't separate you from God's amazing love!

1 READ ABOUT IT!

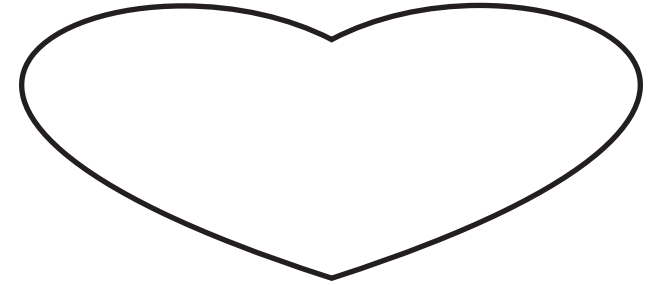
"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

—1 John 1:9

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

When you ask Jesus to be your Savior, you become part of God's family! God is with you to help you love Him and follow Him. But sometimes, you will still choose to go your own way instead of God's. This verse tells us what God wants you to do when you sin. He wants you to confess—tell God you are sorry for what you did and you agree with Him that what you did was wrong. Ask God to help you do what's right. And remember, God has forgiven your sin through Jesus. He never stops loving you! Not even your sin can separate you from God's love!

1 READ ABOUT IT!

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

This verse was written to God's people. If you believe in Jesus as your Savior, you are one of God's people! You can know that God has good plans for you. And God's plans always work out right! This doesn't mean there won't be hard or bad times in your life. But when hard things happen, you can be confident God can and will work through them for good. You don't have to be afraid! Nothing in the future can separate you from God's love!

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

When you know Jesus as your Savior, you don't have to be afraid of what other people might say about you or do to you. God is in control of everything! Even when people mistreat you, God loves you. He is with you and will comfort you and help you do what's right. He may not do what you want Him to, but you can trust Him to use even the worst things for good. God often uses other people to help. If someone is hurting you, you should talk to an adult you trust about it. Remember, no one can separate you from the love of God!
