1 READ ABOUT IT!

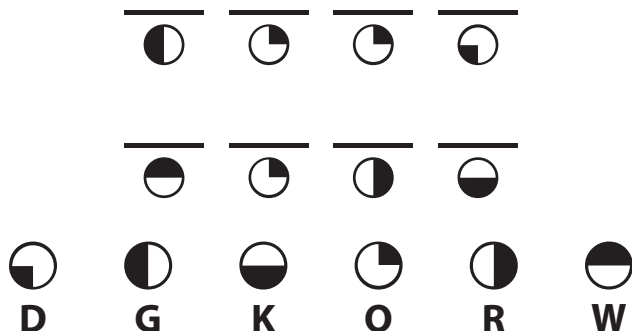
"Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform [finish] it until the day of Jesus Christ."

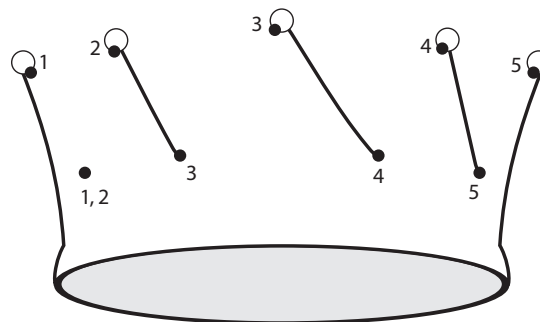

① READ ABOUT IT!

"As for God, his way is perfect: the word of the Lord is tried [shown to be true]: he is a buckler [shield] to all those that trust in him."

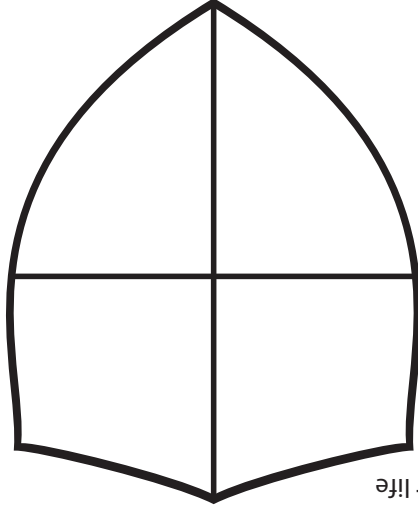
—Psalm 18:30

③ PRAY ABOUT IT!

Thank God that He is perfect and that He takes care of you!

② THINK ABOUT IT!

God is perfect! Everything He does is right and good. You can trust Him! This verse says God is like a shield for those who trust Him. He will take care of you. You can trust God to work in good ways in your life because He is perfect.

Day 3
① READ ABOUT IT!

"If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally [generously]...and it shall be given him." —James 1:5

③ PRAY ABOUT IT!

Thank God that He is wise and knows everything. Ask Him for wisdom to help you know the best things to do and say.

② THINK ABOUT IT!

God knows everything, including what is best. He is wise and freely shares His wisdom. Sometimes He helps you know what to do through a truth from the Bible. Sometimes He uses other people to point you to His way. As you learn more about God, you will learn more about His wisdom. You can trust He knows what is best for you. You can ask God for wisdom and He will help you know what is best to do or say.

② THINK ABOUT IT!

Day 4
① READ ABOUT IT!

"In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you." —1 Thessalonians 5:18

③ PRAY ABOUT IT!

Spend a few minutes thanking God using what you just wrote. Thank Him that He knows what is best.

② THINK ABOUT IT!

When God made you, He gave you the ability to taste food. Life would be pretty boring if we couldn't taste our food! When you taste something, you experience and enjoy it. That's what "taste" means in this verse—to enjoy knowing that God is good. Because God is good you can trust in Him!
