2 PRAY ABOUT IT!

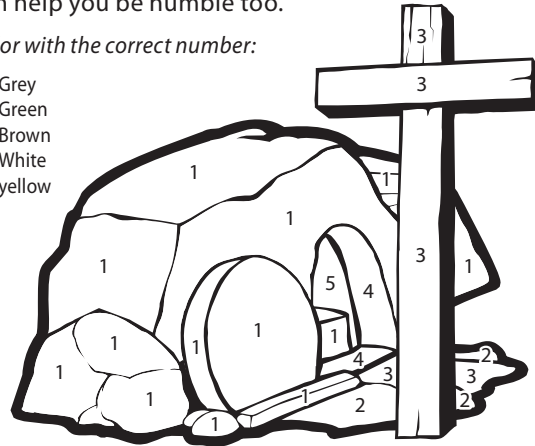
Thank Jesus for being humble and dying on the cross for your sins! If you haven't believed on Him as your Savior, why not believe today?

3 THINK ABOUT IT!

These verses are talking about Jesus! Jesus showed what it means to be humble. He lived in Heaven but came to Earth as a baby. God the Son became a human baby! He continued to humble Himself as He served others and then died on the cross for our sins. Because Jesus was humble, He can help you be humble too.

Day 1
1 READ ABOUT IT!

"But he [God] gives more grace. Therefore it says, 'God opposes [is against] the proud but gives grace to the humble.'"

—James 4:6

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Ask God to give you the grace to be humble. Can you think of someone you need to put before yourself? Ask God to help you do that.

Day 2
1 READ ABOUT IT!

"Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you."

—James 4:10

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Ask God to help you be humble and trust His plan to make a difference through you.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

Grace is undeserved love and kindness. By God's grace He loves you and helps you every day. He wants to give you His grace to love and help others. The proud only think of themselves but those who are humble think of others. They think about other people's thoughts, feelings, and needs. Do you think of yourself first or others first?

Day 3
1 READ ABOUT IT!

"Pride goes before destruction, and a haughty spirit [proudful attitude] before a fall."

—Proverbs 16:18

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Ask God to keep you from pride and help you trust Him and love others.

Day 4
1 READ ABOUT IT!

"Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit [pride], but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others."

—Philippians 2:3-4

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Ask God to help you be helpful, generous, and kind to others.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

The Bible says that God hates sin. Pride (thinking too much of yourself) is a sin and will get you in big trouble! When you think you can do something on your own because you know better than others or God, you will fail. Pride is dangerous because it keeps you from trusting God and loving others.
