—2 Chronicles 20:6

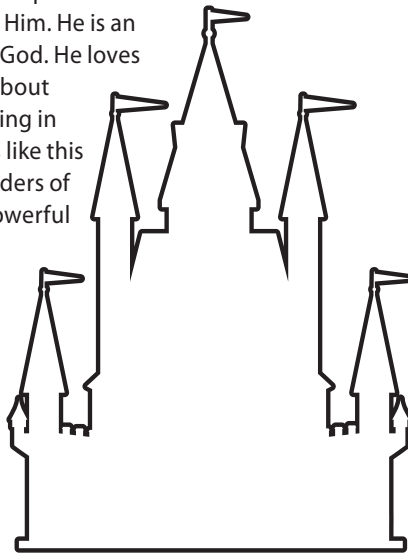
3 PRAY ABOUT IT!
