"How can a young man keep his way pure? By guarding it according to your word."

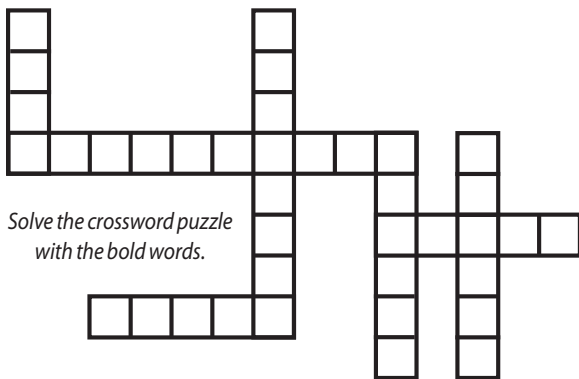

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Thank God for giving you His Word. Ask God to help you study the Bible and for strength to grow to live God's way more each day.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

The **Bible** is God's message to you. It doesn't matter how old you are; you can **study** and learn God's Word. You can **read** it, **listen** at **church** or another place where they teach you truth from God's Word, **memorize** verses and think about them during the day, and use a **devotional** book if you have one. Don't be afraid to ask questions when you don't understand. Studying God's Word helps you grow to live God's way more each day!

1 READ ABOUT IT!

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Have you believed in Jesus? If you have, thank God for forgiving your sins. If not, it is an important decision you can make right now.

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

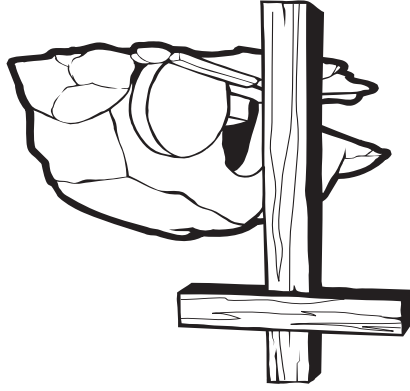
"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

—*1 John 1:9*

Think about your life. Is there something you know you did wrong? Tell God about it. Tell Him you know you were wrong and you are sorry. Ask Him to help you do what is right next time.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

Redemption means to buy back. Jesus paid the highest price to forgive your sins. He took the punishment you deserve and gave His life for you. When you believe in Him, all your sins are forgiven and you are made right with God. That means you have a friendship with God that starts now and lasts forever. He is always with you. He will never stop loving you.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

What do you do when you sin after you have believed in Jesus? God wants you to confess your sin to Him. To confess means to tell God you know what you did was against Him (or wrong). If you have believed in Jesus, God has forgiven your sin! Because God always does what He says, you can know He has forgiven you. If what you did hurt someone else, it is also good to tell them you are sorry and ask them for forgiveness too.

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come."

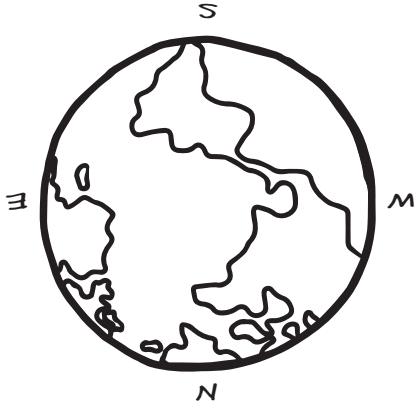
—*2 Corinthians 5:17*

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Thank God for making you new! Ask Him to help you want to live His way more each day.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

It's impossible for God's love to end. His love for you is so great it's like trying to touch the stars. It's impossible for the east to touch the west. God's forgiveness is like that. God's forgiveness isn't temporary. When you trust Jesus, He remembers your sin no more.
