

① READ ABOUT IT!

"...The harvest is plentiful [big], but the laborers [workers] are few; therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest [God] to send out laborers into his harvest."

—**Matthew 9:37-38**

③ PRAY ABOUT IT!

Ask God to send more workers to tell people around the world about Jesus. Ask Him to help you share the Good News of Jesus with others too!

② THINK ABOUT IT!

This verse is comparing people hearing and believing in Jesus to a harvest. At harvest time, food is ripe and ready to be gathered in. The "laborers" in the verse are people who tell others about Jesus. You can pray to God, the Lord of the harvest, and ask Him to send more people to tell others about Jesus. Maybe God is preparing you to be one of those people!

Color in the different types of fruit and think about the harvest of people waiting to hear the Good News of Jesus.

Keep reviewing your verse this week.

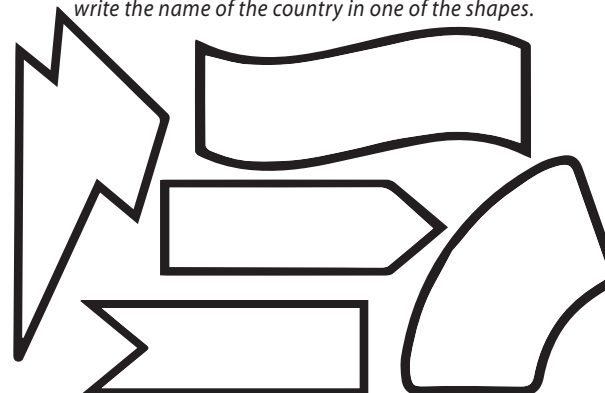
"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come."
2 Corinthians 5:17

There are billions of people in the world and they need to hear the truth that Jesus loves them and died for their sins. Will you be one of the people who tells others this amazing truth? 1 Corinthians 15:3-4 is a great verse to use to help you if you aren't sure what to say.

"...Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures."
1 Corinthians 15:3-4

The Good News of Jesus is for everyone—no matter where they are from, what they look like, or what language they speak. Jesus came for people from every country and nationality in the world! Each of your Quiet Time verses will talk about how the Gospel is for everyone and how you can share this Good News with others!

1 READ ABOUT IT!

"...the same Lord is Lord of all, bestowing his riches on all who call on him. For 'everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.'"

—Romans 10:12-13

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Thank God for His great love for you and for people from all over the world. Ask Him to help you show His love to others—even people who aren't like you.

1 READ ABOUT IT!

(Go back and read day 1's verses then read this one. It comes right after!)

"How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching [telling them]?"

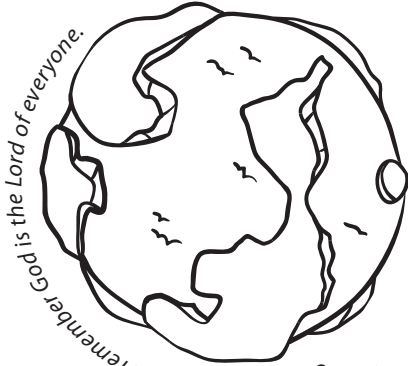

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Ask God to help you have the right words to say when you tell others about Jesus.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

God is the Lord of all—no matter what they look like, who their families are, or where they are from. He gives His great love and goodness to all who call on Him. Calling on Jesus isn't making a phone call. It is trusting Him with your whole life. When you call on Jesus, you are believing He died on the cross to save you from your sins and give you a friendship with God. If you haven't believed in Jesus, you can do that today!



2 THINK ABOUT IT!

The Good News of Jesus is for everyone who believes! But how will people believe in Jesus if they have never heard about Him? Have you ever told someone about Jesus? If you have believed in Jesus as your Savior, you can tell others about Him! God has chosen to use you to share His Good News!

Can you remember who told you about Jesus? Draw a picture of him or her then draw a picture of someone you can tell about Jesus.

1 READ ABOUT IT!

(Go back and read day 2's verses then read this one. It comes right after!)

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Tell God about your friends who don't believe in Jesus. Ask Him to give you the courage to tell them about Jesus.

1 READ ABOUT IT!

"For I am not ashamed [embarrassed] of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes..."

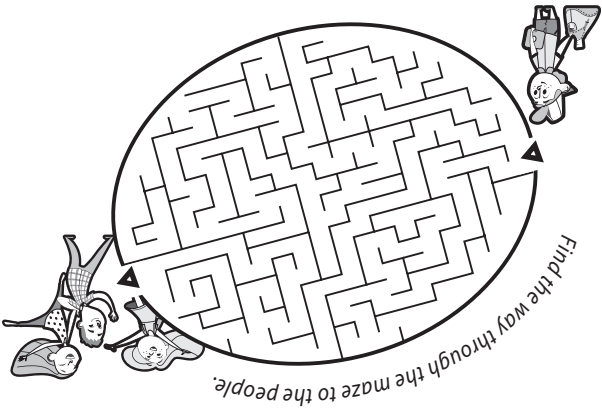
—Romans 1:16

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Thank God for the power of the Gospel in your life. Ask Him to help you be bold to share the Gospel with others.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

When something exciting happens in your life, do you like to tell other people? God says that those who share His Good News are beautiful. The Good News of Jesus is the best news of all! You can tell others the exciting news that God loves them so much He sent His Son Jesus to take the punishment for their sins. They can now be close to God!



2 THINK ABOUT IT!

The truth of the Gospel—that Jesus died on the cross and rose again for our sins—is for everyone who believes! Anyone who believes in Jesus is saved from sin and given new life. You can boldly tell this Good News to others. You don't need to be embarrassed for believing in Jesus or telling others about Him.
